**PRE CONFERENCE TOUR PROGRAM TO ST. PETERSBURG N1
«RUSSIAN NORTHERN VENICE”
13-16 May 2014**

Tuesday, May 13

Early morning transfer from hotels to Leningradskij railway station and departure to St.Petersburg by Sapsan N 152, Moscow . Meeting at the Moskovskij railway station in St. Petersburg and transfer to the local restaurant in the city center. After meal we start with St. Petersburg with the city tour. You will have a chance to see the most beautiful architectural ensembles of the 18-20th centuries and get acquainted with the history of the construction of St.Petersburg visiting Nevsky Avenu, Admiralty, the Summer Garden, the building of Mariinsky theatre, and bridges across the Neva river, including visit to Peter & Paul Fortress. In the evening we arrive to the hotel. Evening is free for optional tour- visit to Mihailovsky theatre.

Wednesday, May 14

Morning departure to Pushkin city (Tsarskoe selo) - Royal Summer residence which is located 25 km south of St.Petersburg. Luxurious palace interiors are decorated with mirrors, paintings and fine gilded carvings. Great Hall (Throne Room) is especially impressive. Another fascinating interior is that of the Picture Gallery containing works by West-European artists of the 17th and 18th centuries. The palace is surrounded by the beautiful park designed in French style.

After lunch at the local restaurant we go back to St. Petersburg and continue with the Hermitage Museum - one of the greatest museums in the world. Five historical buildings, including Winter Palace – the residence of Russian tsars, make the basis of the museum complex. The Hermitage keeps about 3 million monuments of culture and art of the European and Oriental peoples, from high antiquity till nowadays. After the Hermitage we will go back to the hotel.

Thursday, May 15

Morning departure to Peterhoff- a jewel of the Russian art, a town of parks and fountains. Here we start with the Grand Palace – summer residence of Russian Tsars. Over the two centuries of its existence the Grand Palace has become a kind of treasure-store of outstanding works of art, furniture, bronze, chine, glass and everyday objects. The Grand palace is adjoined by the Lower gardens, designed in English landscape style, from the north and the Upper gardens, designed in French formal style, from the south. Both parks are abundantly decorated with sculptures and fountains: Neptune Fountain and Apollo cascade, Oak Fountain and Square Ponds Fountain of the Upper gardens: Great Cascade with Samson Fountain, Terrace Fountains, Marble Seat Fountains, Favourite Fountain, Triton Fountain, Adam and Eve Fountains of the Lower Gardens. Then you will proceed with lunch at the local restaurant “Summer Palace”. After lunch we depart to St. Petersburg and continue our excursion day with visit to the St. Isaac’s Cathedral. This is the fourth tallest cathedral in the world after St. Peter’s in Rome, St. Paul’s in London and the Santa Maria del Flore in Florence and visit to St. Isaac’s would not be complete without climbing the 262 steps of the spiral staircase to the colonnade walkway. This public gallery is about 43 m above ground and offers a magnificent panoramic view of central St. Petersburg. We will finish the city tour with the Church of Our Savior on the Blood – the memorial church in honor Russian emperor Alexander II. In the end of this day you will enjoy dinner with Folklore show at Nikolaevsky Palace including fourshet with vodka & caviar.

Friday, May 16

Departure to Moscow by sapsan N 157 from the Moskovskij railway station, St. Petersburg . Arrival to the Leningradskij railway station, Moscow and transfer to the hotels: Crowne Plaza, Cassado Plaza, Radisson SAS Ukraine.
